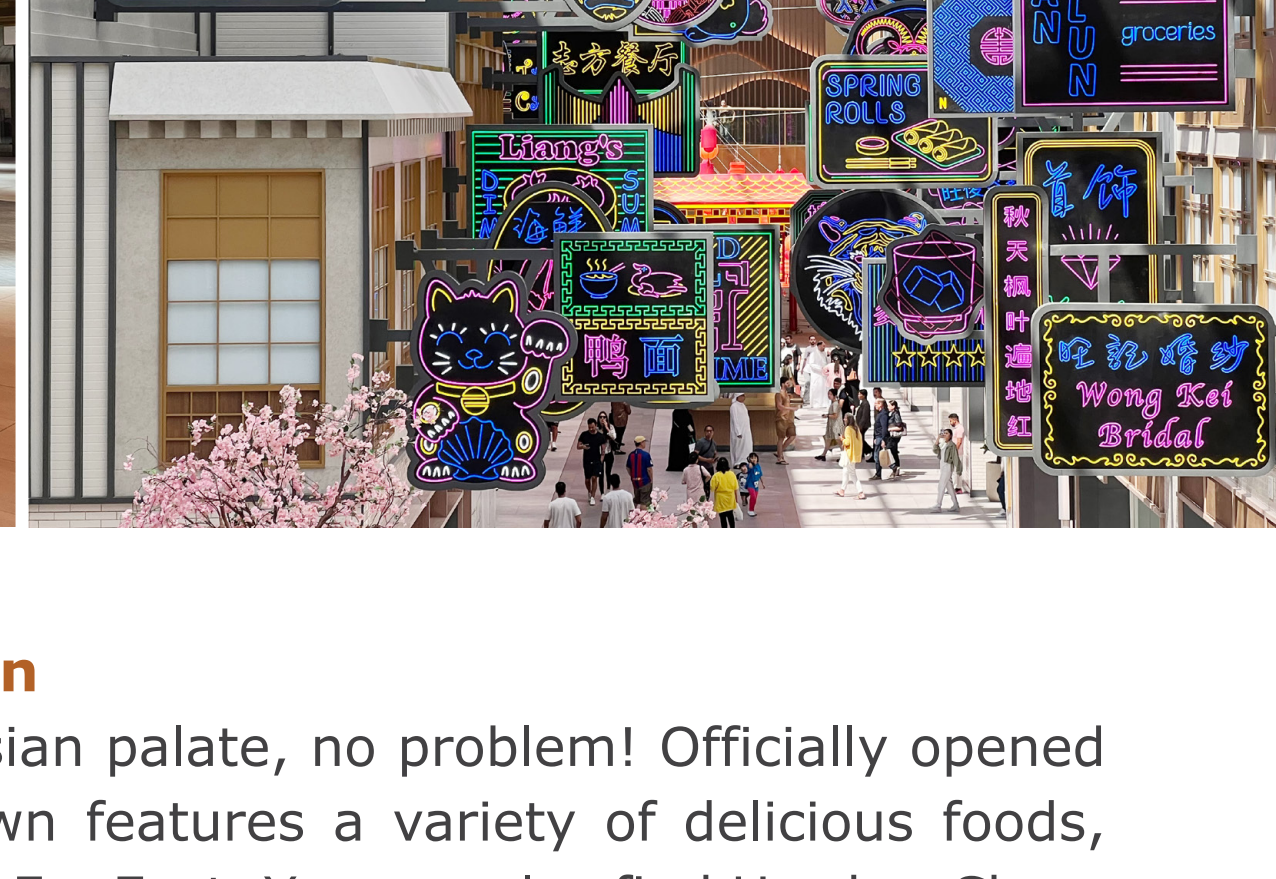

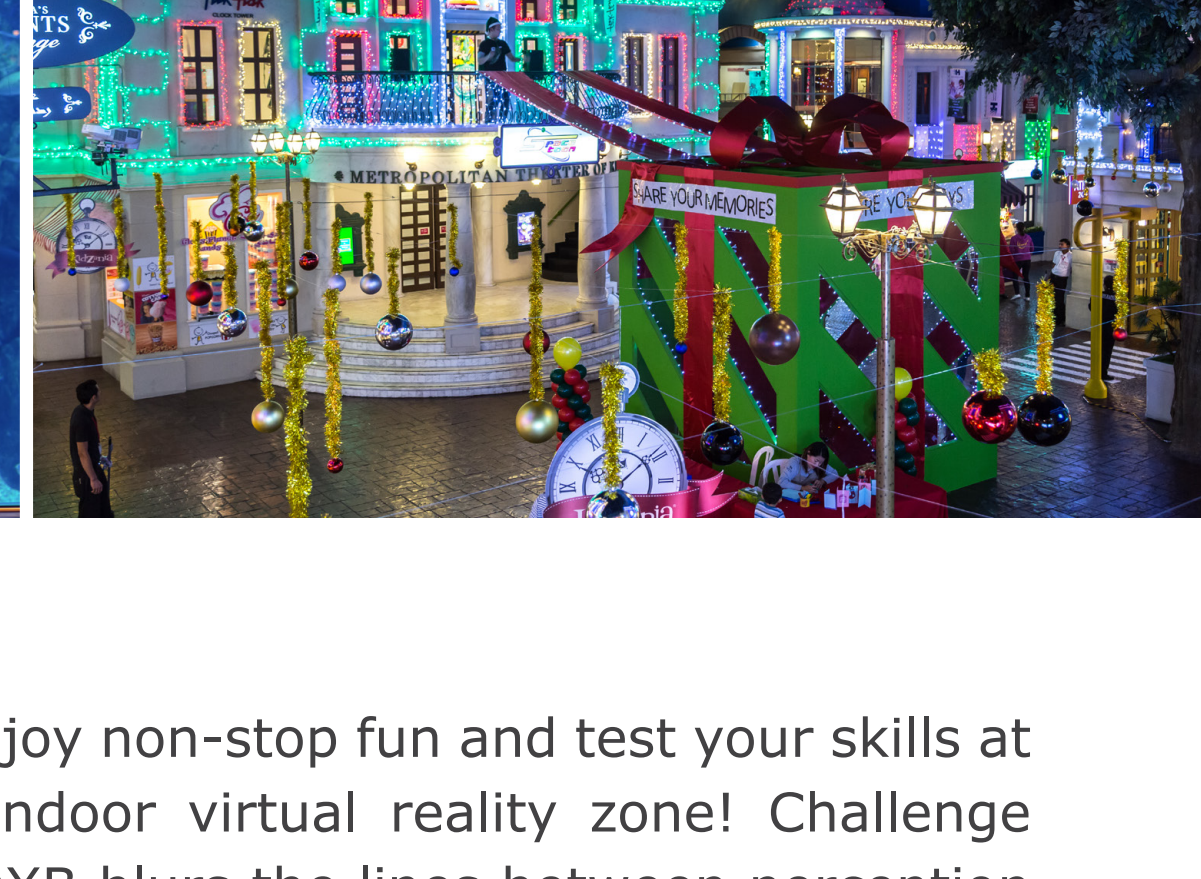
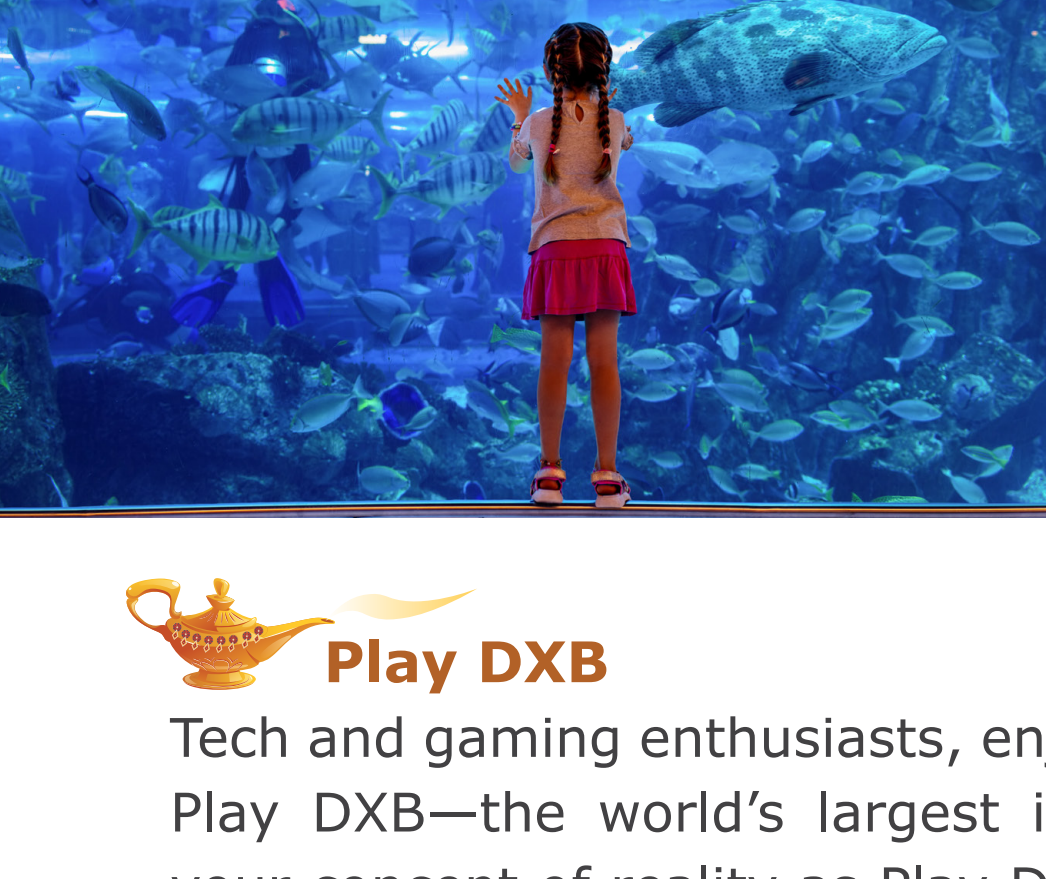


Dubai Mall Chinatown

Burj Khalifa—The World's Tallest Building

Inside, there are 57 elevators, which can travel at speeds of up to 10 meters per second.
